Dear President Meehan,

UMass employees across the system have been through a lot over the past few years, including furloughs, layoffs, and other disruptions. The health and well-being of our members – your employees – has been a topic of renewed importance since the early days of the pandemic. Unfortunately, the latest move by your office and several of the campuses to outsource family and medical (FMLA) leave approvals to a private, for-profit, third-party company shows a disregard for the well-being of those workers, from maintainers to tenured faculty.

FMLA leaves come during stressful times in an employee's life, when they are ill, expecting a child, or caring for a family member. These are times when UMass should offer more, not less support. Outsourcing the management of this important benefit and right to an off-campus, for-profit company raises concerns about the quality of support employees will receive, especially since that company advertises its ability to decrease absenteeism rather than provide necessary leave for employees facing significant family and health concerns. It also diminishes an important area of the employer/employee relationship, substituting an opportunity for engagement with a faceless intermediary. The lack of accountability and connection of such an entity to our campus community also spurs concerns about the security and integrity of employees' private medical and personal information.

The supposed costs that would be saved by this move come at a significant price. It will be paid by employees through added layers of faceless bureaucracy when personal support is what they need. It will be paid by our campus community through the deterioration of the employee/employer relationship. And it will be paid by the students and taxpayers of the Commonwealth as public funds are shifted to private corporations instead of public employees and campus resources.

Our UMass unions are standing united together, along with our members, against this move to privatize FMLA leave administration. This is a bad choice for your employees, for your campuses, and for the public good. We hope that you will rethink this decision and work with the unions to support our human resource departments and ensure that we have robust, on-campus, personal support for family and medical leaves for all employees going forward.
