This a fun, informal reading group which offers the chance to discuss books written by BIPOC authors and creators that you might not encounter in other courses.

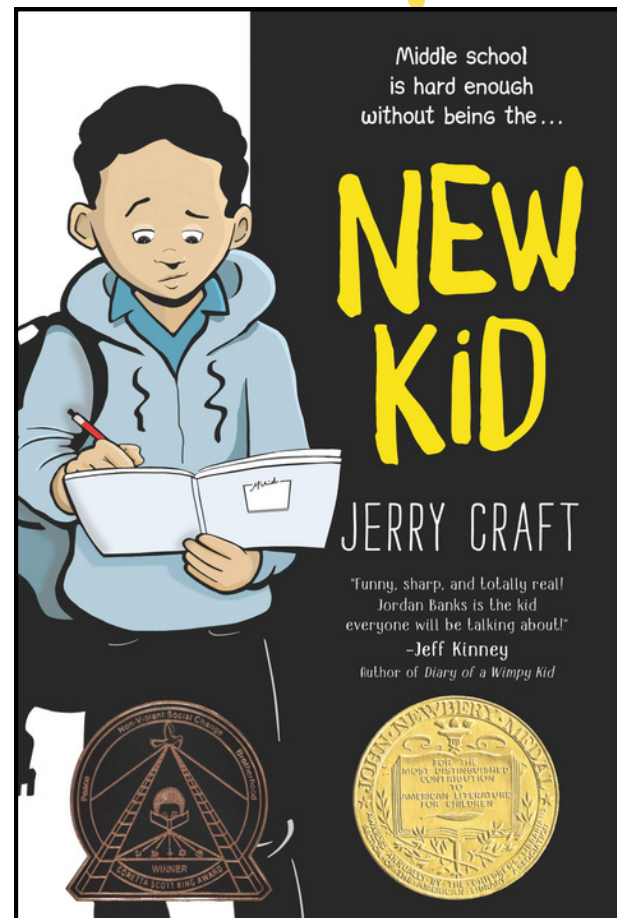
